

## Timetable for Year 11 Trial Exams: January 2025

All exams are in the Hall and at least one other venue. History and Geography examinations are timetabled together. Students doing both will do Geography first and “catch up” later in the Dual Humanities slot afterwards. Dual linguists do French or Spanish first and their other language afterwards. Dual Linguists who combine a second language with another option (Geography, History, PE, Computer Science, Art) will do their other option first and their language examination afterwards. **Students who do both Computer Science and PE will do their Computer Science exam first.** Students are back in lessons on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> January (Periods 3+4) unless they still have exams. Students only attend Art Appraisals, at Mrs Mill’s invitation, if they have no GCSE mock examinations. **The MFL Spanish, French and German Listening examinations will take place on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> January. Dual Linguists will do their other Listening Examination on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> January. The Music Listening Examination will take place on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> January (Periods 3 and 4) in the Music Block.** Full GCSE Examination conditions apply with equipment brought in clear plastic bags. Phones left on front desk. Students not doing examinations will undertake private study in the Hall or in a classroom allocated to them. Any outstanding exams will be mopped up from Friday 17<sup>th</sup> January onwards.
