- be predicted to meet or exceed the standard offer for entry to the Engineering Science degree at Oxford.
- Please note we will prioritise those from backgrounds under-represented at the University of Oxford. On this, I will be actively selecting and prioritising applicants from our link regions.

Overnight accommodation and catering are provided free of charge to successful applicants. Travel bursaries will also be available and more information will follow once offered a place.
