Students are required to conduct a practical investigation, into an idea, issue, concept or theme, supported by written material.  Experimentation & development of theme ideas and techniques. Individual student tutorials.	Component 1: Personal Investigation (7201/C) - continued. The focus of the investigation must be identified independently by the student and must lead to a finished outcome or a series of related finished outcomes.  The investigation should be a coherent, in-depth study that demonstrates the student's ability to construct and develop a sustained line of reasoning from an initial starting point to a final realisation.
