We recognise the indivisibility of 'Presence, Compassion, Liberation'.

- Presence requires us to 'be with' those we work with and for. It calls us to listen, understand, accept, affirm and protect all people and all of creation.
- · Compassion demands that we hear the cry of people made poor and respond with loving action.
- · Liberation inspires us to work towards restoring the dignity of all people, recognising their fundamental Human Rights. It affords all people within our Network the freedom to become the person they want be and amplifies the voice of those made poor.



#### **Our branches - Ministries**

Our branches represent the diverse range of activities that exist under the canopy of the Network. They have grown naturally from the boughs. They are sustained and nourished by the soil, roots and trunk, and they are the vessels that allow staff, students, parents, Brothers and volunteers to make a difference locally and globally.
