Music	Harmony, Beauty, Transcendence	Music lifts the soul and reflects divine harmony	Choral singing, sacred music traditions, composing reflective pieces
PE	Virtue, Discipline, Health as Gift	The human body is good and created in God's image; sport develops virtue	Teamwork, perseverance, respect, celebrating physical ability

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PD	Justice, Solidarity, Peace, Human Rights	Encourages moral responsibility, empathy, and participation in building a just society	Exploring dignity of work, anti-poverty efforts, ethical leadership
Computer Science	Human Creativity, Innovation for the Common Good	Technology must serve human dignity and the common good	Discussions on ethics of AI, digital responsibilities, online safety
